Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: Year 13 results day - Thursday 13th August 2026

It was wonderful to celebrate the end of this year's group's journey with us at Ruislip High School at their Leavers' Assembly and Party. I am writing to explain the arrangements for Year 13 results day on Thursday 13th August 2026. At Ruislip High School we pride ourselves on ensuring that all our students on results day receive the necessary support, advice and guidance they need as they navigate this important milestone.

The school will be open from 8.00am and students are invited to come into school with their parents/guardians to open their results with a member of staff. We will stagger the results collection throughout the early morning, to ensure that each student receives the support they need.

Results will be available for collection in school at the following times. Please arrive, with your child, to school at the specified time to ensure the smooth running of the morning;

8.00am: students with surnames beginning - A, B or C
8.10am: students with surnames beginning - D, E or F
8.20am: students with surnames beginning - G, H or I
8.30am: students with surnames beginning - J, K or L
8.40am: students with surnames beginning - M, N or O
8.50am: students with surnames beginning - P, Q or R
9.00am: students with surnames beginning - S, T or U
9.10am: students with surnames beginning - V or W
9.20am: students with surnames beginning - X, Y or Z.

Students will be able to see the outcome of their individual university application on their UCAS account, and whether they have met the conditions of their offer, from 8am on Thursday 13th August 2026. Students should check this promptly and, should they find they have not met the conditions of either of their university offers, they should come into school as soon as possible after 8am (regardless of their original appointment time), so that we can begin to support them with Clearing as soon as possible, as this is time sensitive.

If students wish to enter Clearing for the opportunity to change university or course, even if they have met the conditions of their original university offer, they should go to the Clearing room in school straight after their appointment on results day before making any decisions. I strongly recommend students considering Clearing print out and complete this [pre-Clearing](#) plan before results day, and bring it with them in the morning. Should students be on holiday on results day, results will be posted home, or students can send a nominated adult to collect results on the student's behalf as long as they bring written permission signed by the student, and ID to confirm their own identity. Students can still arrange a remote appointment with a member of the Sixth Form team for support if they have not met the conditions of either their firm or insurance university offer by emailing me ahead of results day.

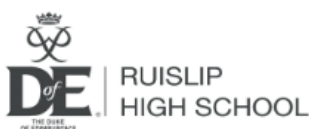
