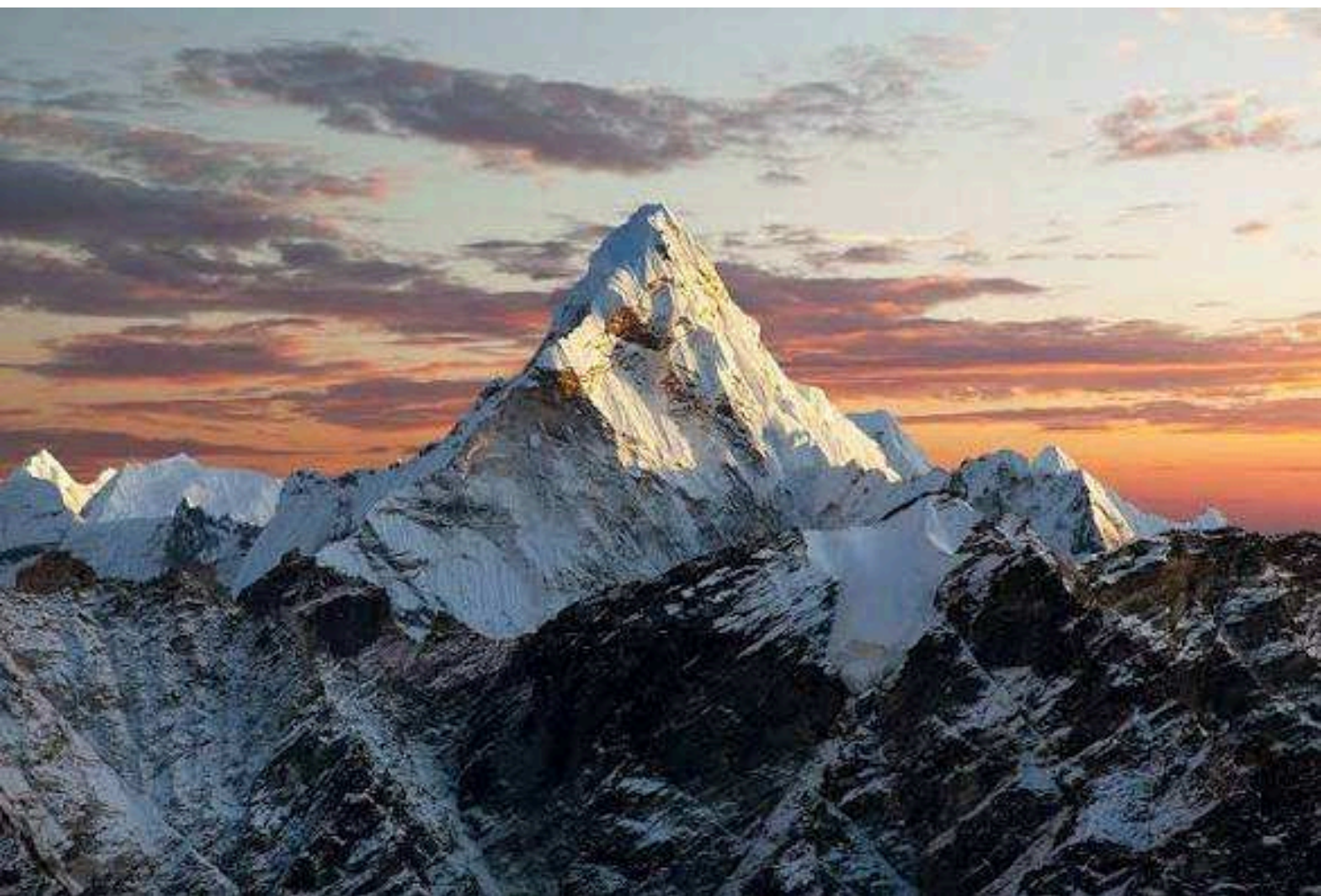

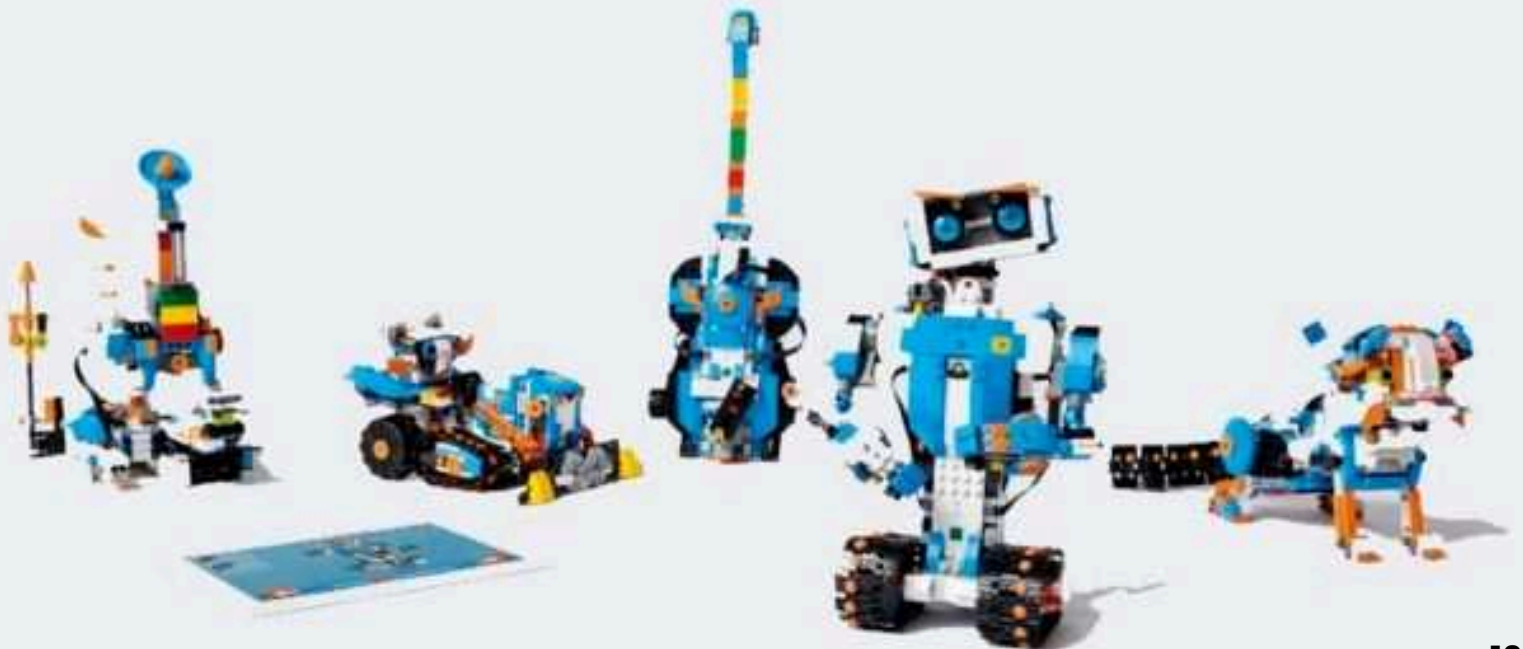

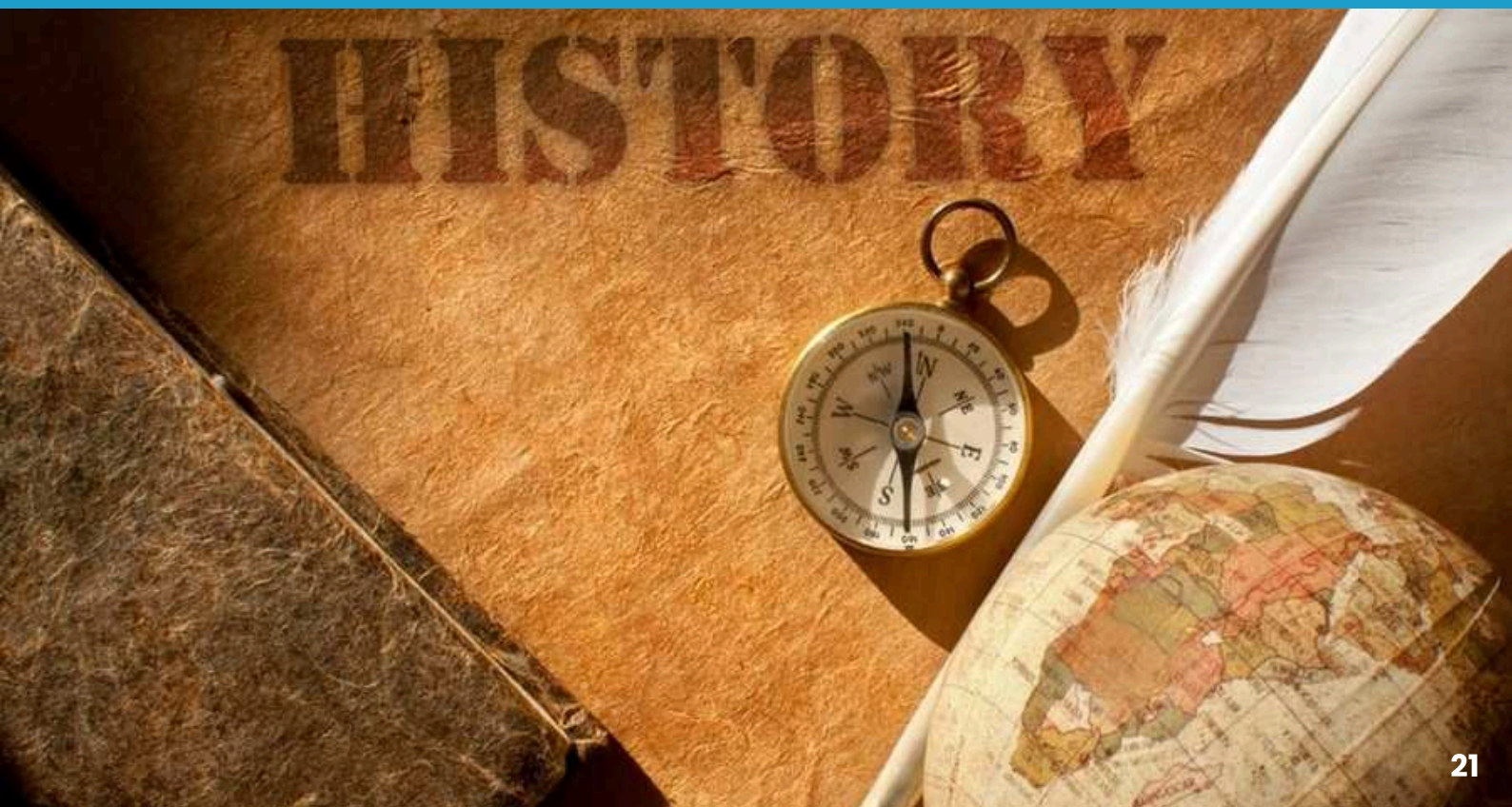


# HISTORY MAGAZINE CLUB

Unlike traditional gym routines, these clubs blend martial arts discipline with a social, ego-free atmosphere designed specifically to help girls and women thrive.



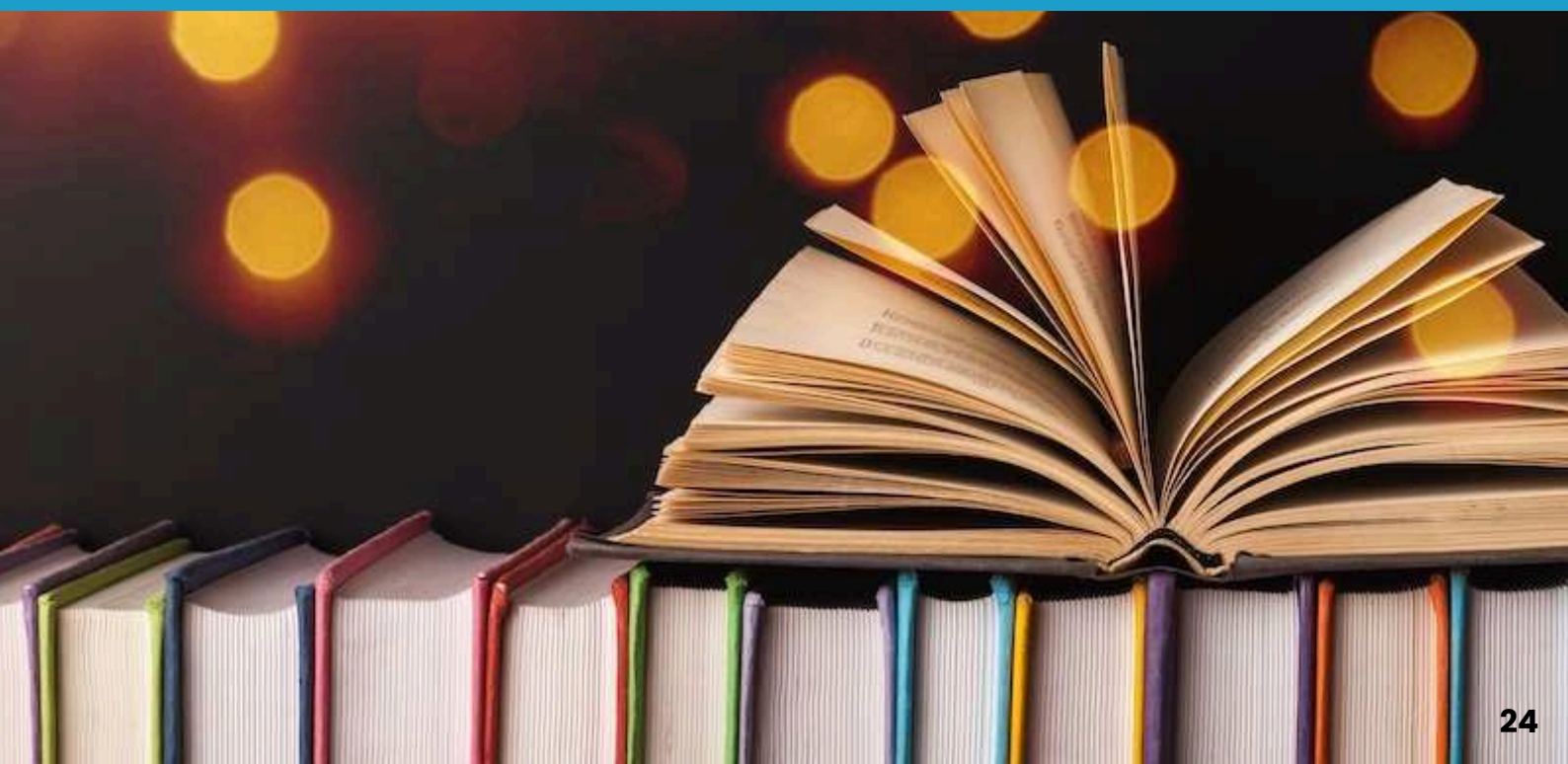
