On Tuesday 24th February 2026, from 6.00–7.00pm, we will be welcoming an expert speaker from the [Breck Bednar Foundation](#), a nationally recognised organisation specialising in online safety and child protection.

The presentation will focus on how parents can effectively support and protect their children in the online world. It is based on the real-life story of a teenager who tragically lost his life as a result of online grooming, and it powerfully highlights the warning signs, risks, and practical steps parents can take to keep their children safe. While the subject matter is serious, the session is informative, accessible, and empowering, giving parents clear guidance and confidence.

All Year 7 students will hear a student-friendly version of this presentation during the school day and all Year 8, 9 and 10 students attended last year. We believe that combining this with a parent session is essential in strengthening our safeguarding approach and ensuring that home and school are working together to support young people.

To make the evening even more welcoming tea and coffee will be served from 5.30pm and the Friends of RHS will be hosting a pre-loved uniform sale. All parents who attend the presentation will be entered into a raffle to win a £50 restaurant voucher, drawn on the evening.
