Lockers

Students must make sure their lockers are emptied and clear of any rubbish by Friday 16th June 2023. Any items left in lockers after this date will be thrown away.

Plan for Friday 16 June 2023

On Friday 16 June 2023, all students will sit a science exam in the morning. Following this exam, students who **do not** take GCSE Geography will need to leave the school site immediately and go home. These students will need to sign out at main reception and return to school at 2.45pm for the Celebration Assembly. Staff will be on duty to make sure students go directly home and do not congregate outside the school, if there are any behavioural issues students will be uninvited to the Celebration Assembly that afternoon. Students sitting the Geography exam in the afternoon will stay in school all day.

At around 3pm there will be the Celebration Assembly, followed by time for students to sign shirts and enjoy an ice cream in the sunshine with their teachers. Students will be leaving school at around 3.45pm and will need to go directly home. Any poor behaviour during this celebratory afternoon will result in students being unable to attend the Prom. A reminder that students need to be in full school uniform on this day, but should bring a spare shirt (and marker pens) for signing. This will be the last day of the academic year for Year 11 and they should not return to school after this date, until we welcome the majority of students back on 12th July 2023 for Sixth Form Induction Day.

Year 11 Prom - Thursday 29th June 2023

The vast majority of students will be celebrating the end of Year 11 at the Prom on Thursday 29th June 2023, at Denham Grove Hotel, Tilehouse Lane, Denham, Uxbridge UB9 5DG. Students will be given their Prom ticket at the Celebration Assembly next week. Students and their families are welcome to take photographs outside the school before arriving at the venue. Students need to arrive at the hotel between 7.00-7.30pm and there will be another opportunity for photographs with family and friends here. A buffet will be served from 8pm, followed by a short awards ceremony and dancing until 11pm. Please note any dietary requirements for your child [here](#) by Friday 16th June. Students will need to bring a card if they wish to purchase any soft drinks throughout the evening. **All students must be picked up promptly at 11pm.** Any taxis need to be booked in advance as the hotel is fairly remote. We want students to have a really enjoyable evening; however, if students are found to be behaving inappropriately, vaping, smoking or having consumed any alcohol or drugs, they will be asked to leave the Prom immediately by security and parents/guardians will be contacted. Any behaviour of this nature will also put a student's place at sixth form at risk.
