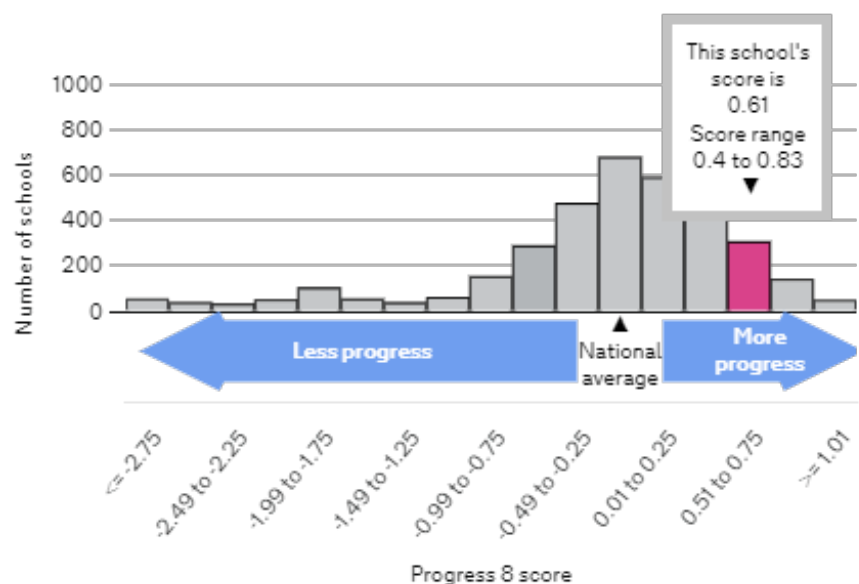

Ruislip High School is pleased to report some exceptional attainment by its pupils in their GCSE and other qualifications this summer. Overall, our pupils achieved 37% of grades at 9-7, 71% 9-5 and 84% 9-4 and we had some exceptional individual results:

- Daniel – Nine grade 9s; Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, French Geography, History, English Language and English Literature
- Jasmyrn - Nine grade 9s; Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Spanish Geography, Art, English Language and English Literature
- Luvai - Seven grade 9s; English Literature, Computer Science, English Language, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and a grade 8 in Geography
- Sasmita - Five grade 9s; English Literature, English Language, Geography, History, Media Studies and grade 8 in Mathematics and Physics.

Gareth Davies, Headteacher of Ruislip High School said: "I am delighted that our Year 11 students have not only achieved exceptional GCSE results but that the vast majority of students will be continuing their learning journey in Ruislip High School's sixth form.
