Year group	Activity	Delivery	When	Detail
12 and 13	Tutor programme	Sixth Form team	All year	Students complete a robust programme which includes planning for their post-18 careers.
12	University visits	Sixth Form team	Autumn term	All Year 12 students attend a trip to a university.
12	Post-18 information evening	Sixth Form team	Spring term	All Year 12 students and parents are invited to attend an evening hosted by the school to help inform students of possible career pathways post-18.
12	Head Students and Student Leadership Team applications	Students and staff	Spring term	Applications are invited from students interested in applying to become Head Students or part of the Student Leadership Team. The application process mirrors the process of employer applications by requiring students to complete a presentation and attend an interview.
12	Post-18 options week	Sixth Form team	Summer term	Students complete a week-long programme to prepare for post-18 options.
12	Work experience	Students and Sixth Form team	Summer term	Students complete a week-long work experience placement.
13	University applications	Staff and students	Autumn term	There is detailed planning of students' university applications with senior staff.
12	Speaker programme	Various charities and employers	All year	Students attend a speaker programme at least twice per half-term, which includes employers and higher education providers who give an insight into their industry.

12 and 13	Careers support	Careers advisor	All year	Students are able to meet with our careers advisor, on request.
12 and 13	Unifrog	Tutor time	All year	Students have support from an online system, known as Unifrog, which helps to support their applications to employment/apprenticeships/university.
Year 12 and 13	D of E	D of E weekends and practice sessions	All year	Opportunity for students to develop their teamwork and organisational skills
Year 12 and 13	Tutorial and Parent Bulletin	Tutorial and Email	Weekly	Opportunities offered by further education providers and companies shared weekly with parents and students.
