**Re: Arrangements for Citizenship GCSE examination dates**

I am writing to inform you about the arrangements for the upcoming Citizenship GCSE examinations, scheduled for **Thursday 7th May 2026, at 1:00 pm** and **Thursday 14th May 2026, at 1:00 pm**. Students are expected to attend school as usual on both days, although there will be amendments to their timetables.

On the mornings of **7th May and 14th May**, students will participate in additional revision sessions. These sessions will be led by their Citizenship teacher and will also include independent revision periods in designated quiet study rooms. During the teacher-led sessions, students will receive targeted revision support, learn strategies for success in the examinations, and have the opportunity to discuss any questions or concerns with their Citizenship teachers. Revision materials will be provided for all students to use during the independent revision sessions. The specific timings of these sessions will be communicated to students via Google Classroom.
