Entry requirements

All students must achieve **at least five grade 4s at GCSE** to be able to study at Ruislip High School Sixth Form.

For most subjects, there are additional subject specific requirements.

For example, to study A Level Mathematics a student must also have a Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics.

Timeline for September 2026 entry

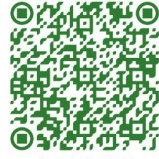
- **Wednesday 12th November 2025: Sixth Form Open Evening at school from 5.00pm-7.30pm. Applications open.**
- **Friday 23rd January 2026 at 4pm: Application form deadline.**
- **By Friday 28th February 2026: Students find out via email if they have been invited to an interview.** Selection for interview is based on the strength of the application form and predicted GCSE grades.
- **Wednesday 4th March 2026: Interview day in school for internal students. Interviews for external candidates to be arranged.**
- **Thursday 2nd April 2026: Candidates will be notified of the provisional outcome of their application by this date.** All places are conditional upon candidates meeting the academic criteria when they receive their results.
- **Tuesday 30th June 2026: Sixth Form Induction Day**
- **Thursday 20th August 2026: GCSE results day and Sixth Form enrolment**
