Re: Year 7 Residential Trip: PGL Liddington

In July 2026, we are proposing to take a group of Year 7 students on an exciting trip to PGL Liddington. The visit will depart on the morning of **Friday 10th July 2026**, returning in the afternoon of **Sunday 12th July 2026**. The provisional itinerary is likely to be as follows although specific activities and timings will be confirmed closer to the time:

Day 1

Friday 10th July

08:30 Arrive at school - register and medical check
09:30 Depart school
11:30 Arrive at PGL
12:00 Packed Lunch and check in
14:00 Afternoon activities

Day 2

Saturday 11th July

Breakfast at accommodation
Full day of activities

Day 3

Sunday 12th July

07:45 Check out and breakfast
09:00 Morning activities
12:00 Lunch
13:00 Depart
15:00 Arrive back at school

The cost of the trip is **£195**, which includes:

- Full board accommodation. Students will be sharing ensuite rooms in groups of 4-6
- Dinner will be provided on the first day
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided on the full day of activities
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided on the third day
- Activities led by well trained and enthusiastic members of PGL staff
- Travel to and from Liddington by coach

A deposit of **£50** will also be required via ParentPay by **13th February 2026**. This will be refunded if the trip is oversubscribed, but this becomes non-refundable after the place has been confirmed as payments are then made

to the travel company. Places will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis, and **as this is a popular trip we would encourage early deposits.**

The payment option on Parent Pay will go live on **Monday 9th February 2026 at 4pm..**

Further non-refundable payments will be payable by:

- **06/03/2026 - £50**
- **03/04/2026 - £50**
- **01/05/2026 - £45**

Partial payments via ParentPay can be made before the last payment date. Please note that the school makes payment to the travel company on the above dates, and therefore refunds cannot be issued except where valid claims can be made on the travel insurance policy. Please also be aware that participation is subject to the terms of the School Visits Contract.
