The dish can be any of their choosing - from breakfast to brunch, dinner to dessert - so long as the student is happy to share a photo of their final creation and the recipe with us via their tutor group Google Classroom, using the template provided below. Please note that your child's name and form will be published along with the recipe if it gets chosen and by allowing your child to take part you are giving consent for this information to be included. Should you not want your child's name and form to be included please contact your child's Head of Year.

Please use <u>this template</u> to submit your recipes. Any pictures or interesting facts about the recipe should be included (please do not include photographs of your child). The deadline to send your recipes is **Friday 19th January, 2024.** These should be submitted via your child's Google Classroom, where your child's tutor will have set this as an optional assignment under the title: 'RHS Recipe Book Competition'.

The top 50 recipes will be selected and published in the book. However, **all entries will be entered into our recipe raffle draw**. The raffle prize will be a free copy of the recipe book and a £25 Sainsburys Voucher to recreate some of the recipes at home with your friends and family. The winner of the raffle will be announced during Equalities Week 2024. There is a limit of one entry per student. Once the book is published it will be available to purchase from school with the aim of raising money for the school charities. Details surrounding cost will be released in due course.
