Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: Sixth Form Induction Day - Tuesday 30th June

We have been extremely proud of how Year 11 have conducted themselves throughout the examination period. As these all-important examinations begin to draw to a close, I would like to share more information about the upcoming Sixth Form Induction Day, which will take place on Tuesday 30th June.

When accepting a place to study at Ruislip High School Sixth Form, students know they are required to attend the Induction Day. This day is essential in ensuring all students know what to expect in September and have the necessary information to prepare fully for the start of their post-16 studies.

Students should arrive via the front door to school at 8.45am on Tuesday 30th June. They will be expected to remain in school until 3pm that day. Students should bring a water bottle and a packed lunch (if they wish). Students will be able to use the Sixth Form cafe at break and lunchtime, but will only be able to use a debit card on this occasion (their school ID cards will be set up for September usage, and will work exactly as they did in the lower school).

We expect students to adhere to the full, smart Sixth Form dress code. Full details of the dress code, including exemplar photographs, can be found [here](#).

Following the Induction Day, students should complete the summer transition work for their chosen Sixth Form subjects. This will be available on the "Join Us" section of the Sixth Form part of the school website from 30th June. Students should bring their work with them to the first day of term on 4th September 2026.

Some important dates for your diary;

- Thursday 20th August - GCSE results and Sixth Form enrolment day. All Year 11 students are expected to attend school that morning to receive their results and to formally enrol in the Sixth Form. More information will be sent to you soon about results day.
- Friday 4th September - first day of term for students. All Sixth Form students will be expected in school from 8.25am that morning.
- Thursday 17th September - Success in the Sixth Form information evening. This important evening will run from 5-6pm, for parents/guardians and students in school.

I would encourage you and your child to begin familiarising yourself with our Sixth Form Student Handbook, which is available [here](#). This document has everything you need to know about life at Sixth Form and will be resent after results day.
