Dear Parents/Guardians

**Re: Sixth Form Induction Day (Tuesday 8th July) and other Sixth Form matters**

I am sure you will join me in congratulating the Year 11 students on their excellent hard work and revision throughout the exam period. With the exams now finished, I am writing with further details of the Sixth Form Induction Day, which takes place on Tuesday 8th July.

When accepting a place to study at Ruislip High School Sixth Form, students are required to attend the Sixth Form Induction Day on Tuesday 8th July. This day is essential in ensuring all students know what to expect in September and have the necessary information and equipment to prepare fully for the start of their post-16 studies.

Students should arrive via the front door to school by **9.50am on Tuesday 8th July**. They will be expected to remain in school until 3pm that day.

What to bring

Students should bring their pencil case, a water bottle and a packed lunch. Students will be able to use the Sixth Form cafe at lunchtime, but will only be able to use a debit card on this occasion (their school ID cards will be set up for September usage, and will work exactly as they did in the lower school).

What to wear

On induction day, we do not expect students to adhere to the full smart Sixth Form dress code, as we recognise that students may need time over the summer to acquire the correct items. We therefore expect students to come to induction day dressed "smart-casual". [This link](#) provides guidance on what can be worn on induction day.

After the induction day

Following the induction day, students should complete the summer preparatory work for their chosen Sixth Form subjects. This will be available on the "Join Us" section of the Sixth Form part of the school website after 8th July. Students should bring their work with them to the first day of term on 3rd September.

- Thursday 21st August - GCSE results and Sixth Form enrolment day. All Year 11 students are expected to attend school that morning to receive their results and to formally enrol in the Sixth Form.
- Wednesday 3rd September - first day of term for students. All Sixth Form students will be expected in school from 8.15am that morning.
- Thursday 11th September - Success in the Sixth Form parent information evening. This will run from 5.30-7pm, for parents/guardians and students, about how to make the most of the two years in the Sixth Form.
