Re: Student Leadership Opportunities

As we approach the end of the spring term, we are starting to look ahead to our current Year 13 students sitting their final exams and leaving Ruislip High School. This allows us to begin the process of selecting the student leadership team for the upcoming school year.

I am therefore delighted to inform you that applications are now open for students currently in Year 12 to apply for the following student leadership positions.

Role	How many positions?	What does the role entail?	How will they be selected?
Student Leadership Team	Head Student and two Deputy Head Students	These are the leaders of the student body at Ruislip High School. These students will be expected to maintain a high profile around the school and will be asked to support the school at various events throughout the year. The students will speak at the Presentation Evening and Sixth Form Open Evening, as well as occasional assemblies. They will lead the team of Sixth Form Ambassadors and work with the Head of Sixth Form and Student Leadership Coordinator throughout the year.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students must complete an application form (link here) Students will be shortlisted to attend an initial round of interviews based on the strength of their application Further shortlisting will take place before a final round of interviews with Mr Davies, Mr Sills and a school governor.
Sixth Form Ambassadors	20	These students will support the Student Leadership Team throughout the year. They will be expected to provide support at at least two evening events (for e.g. a Parents/Guardians Evening for a younger year group), as well as running Sixth Form and charitable events such as Raise and Give (RAG) week and at Sixth Form Open Evening. These students will also be expected to offer support with mentoring students in younger year groups once a week.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students must complete an application form (link here) Students will be selected based on the strength of their application

All students in Year 12 are welcome to apply for either position. Students who apply for the Student Leadership Team and are unsuccessful will be given the opportunity to be considered as a Sixth Form Ambassador, if they so wish.

Applications for both roles close at 9.00am on Tuesday 14th April. Links to the forms can be found in the table above.
