Dear Parents/Guardians

Re: Year 7 Summer School

I would like to take this opportunity to inform parents/guardians of our Year 7 Summer School which is due to take place on Tuesday 1st September 2026. This will give students an opportunity to come into the school and take part in a range of activities across a range of subjects. It will also allow the students to get used to the school environment and building before they start.

Students will be working in groups and will have four sessions throughout the day. Each session will run for 1 hour and 15 minutes and students will get a 30 minute break.

The schedule will be as follows:

Session 1: 8:45am - 10:00am

Session 2: 10:00am - 11:15am

Lunch: 11:15am - 11:45am

Session 3: 11:45am - 1:00pm

Session 4: 1:00pm - 2:15pm

Students can arrive from 8:30am and they will be guided to their first session. Students can wear their own clothes and are advised to wear something comfortable and trainers as some of the sessions may contain a physical element. Students also need to bring a packed lunch for the day as the school catering will not be operational on this day. If any student requires any support with this please do contact me via the school office.

If students require any medical equipment such as an epipen or inhaler, they must have this on their person when they arrive and show this to the relevant staff. If students are required to have this and fail to bring it with them on the day then parents/guardians will be asked to collect their child or bring the medical equipment into school.

On the day:

- 1) Students should wait outside the front of school from 8.30am;
- 2) Students should be on time – **no one will be available to let them in if they arrive after 8.45am;**
- 3) It is your responsibility to ensure your child's safe journey to school. The school does not take responsibility for students who inform parents/guardians that they are going to be at school but fail to arrive.
- 4) Students will be dismissed promptly at 2.15pm. It is your responsibility to ensure their safe journey home.
