Dear Parents/Guardians


I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you and your child to Ruislip High School. We appreciate that transfer to secondary school can be a daunting process for students and in order to prepare your child and alleviate any worries they have we have put together this [Student Handbook](#) for them.

All students transferring to us will be spending the day here at Ruislip High School on **Tuesday 7th July 2026**; this will then be followed by a meeting **for parents only** on the evening of 7th July at 6.00pm, where vital information will be shared. Due to seating capacity in the hall we would request, if possible, for just one parent to attend. The 'Friends' of Ruislip High School will be selling nearly-new uniform and pencil cases in the main entrance from 5:15pm.

On Tuesday 7th July 2026 all students should arrive at the school main reception by 8:45am in their full primary school uniform. We kindly ask that students do not arrive before 8:30am to avoid the arrival traffic of the rest of the school; the day will finish at 2:45pm. Students will be given a free lunch on the day so there is no need for parents to supply lunch for their child, however, we would ask that your child bring in a water bottle that they can fill throughout the day and a snack for break time. Students will spend the day in a group of 30 students from various primary schools. Tutor groups will not be finalised until later in July when the school receives further information from primary schools; we will write to you to confirm your child's final tutor group before the end of the summer term.

If your child suffers from asthma, anaphylaxis, epilepsy or diabetes it is very important that you ensure that they bring their inhalers/epipens/buccal/insulin (and any related items) into school with them on that day. Students will be required to keep any emergency medication and a paper copy of their care plan with them at all times throughout the day. It is your responsibility to ensure this is followed. If your child has a medical condition or allergy that the school needs to be aware of, please contact Ms Loizou, Head of Year 7 at office@ruisliphigh.org.uk to ensure we are aware of these in advance.
