# Dear Parents/Guardians

I am writing as we approach the last week of a busy half term at the school and, as you will see from the key dates at the end of this update, next half term will be just as action-packed. Over the past two weeks in particular, students in examination year groups have been working on their external examinations, including GCSEs, A Levels and vocational qualifications. Students have been impressive in terms of their behaviour during examinations and their attitudes to learning during lessons and revision sessions. I have no doubt this impressive behaviour will continue throughout the examination period and after half term there are a number of well-deserved celebration events for students in Years 11 and 13. I particularly look forward to celebrating the end of the examination period with them at celebration assemblies and their proms.

#### Arbor roll out

Our new MIS, Arbor, has been accessed by 78% of parents/guardians since we launched earlier this term. We encourage all parents/guardians to access the Parent Portal and download the application to stay connected with the school, receive important communications, track your child's positive and negative incidents, monitor their attendance, and record absence. The school no longer uses ClassCharts, and parents/guardians will lose access to that application from Monday 3rd June 2025. I would like to thank all parents/guardians for their support and engagement with Arbor this term.

I have been made aware that as part of our transition to Arbor, parents/guardians were asked for important contact and personal information, which is then held securely in our management information system. I was not aware that this request included asking parents to confirm their religion. I am very proud to lead a diverse school community and would like to stress that a child's religious faith is not something that we monitor. With this in mind, I do not believe we need to hold this information and want to assure parents that this information has now been removed from our records.

#### Uniform & after school behaviour

At Ruislip High School, we take pride in the high standards we set for our students, both in their learning and in the way they present themselves. Our uniform plays a key role in fostering a sense of identity, equality, and belonging and I know that many families choose our school because of these high expectations.

While most students wear their uniform correctly, we have recently seen a small number making modifications that do not align with our uniform requirements. These include rolling up skirts to shorten them, using hair bands to tie back jumpers to alter their fit, and wearing trousers too low, which detract from the smart appearance we expect. We are grateful for the support we receive from parents/guardians, and to help us maintain these standards, we ask that you speak to your child about the importance of wearing the uniform correctly and in line with our policy (click <a href="here">here</a>).

Some parents may also be aware of concerns raised on local social media platforms last weekend regarding student behaviour. The school encourages anyone witnessing anti-social behaviour by Ruislip High School students to report it via the office email: <a href="mailto:office@ruisliphighschool.org.uk">office@ruisliphighschool.org.uk</a>. In this instance, the school was able to identify the individuals responsible and issue high-level sanctions. Senior staff have patrolled local parks this week, in













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addition to our usual patrols in the vicinity of the school, and I would again reiterate that we encourage all students to respect our community neighbours and leave the area of the school in a calm and orderly manner. I would emphasise that the vast majority of our students get this right every day, and I would like to thank parents/guardians for their continued support.

### Changes to break and lunch time for Year 9 and Year 10 students

After the half-term break, students in Year 9 will move to the second break and second lunch timetable, in order to enable all year groups to have more space during social times. The Year 9 start and end time will remain the same. Year 9 will move to the atrium and Year 10 will move to the restaurant area.
