**Re: Year 10 Activities Week - Trip on Thursday 6th July, 2023**

Our annual Activities Week will take place from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July to Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023. During the week, on Thursday 6th July, 2023, all Year 10 students will have the opportunity to attend a trip, from a choice of three options.

In order for the plans for the week to be put into place, we would appreciate it if at this stage you could complete an expression of interest form to indicate which of the three trip options your child would like to attend. Details of each option are outlined below.

**Trip 1: Trip to Regents' Park Open Air Theatre**

Think you know Robin Hood? Think again... Students will watch this hilarious new musical comedy in one of London's most atmospheric venues. Students will take part in a musical workshop in school, before departing to Regents' Park. Here students will enjoy their lunch on the lawns of this royal park, before heading to the theatre to enjoy a matinee performance.

Students will travel to and from Regents' Park via the London Underground.

Time of arrival at school: 8:50am

Location: Registration in various classrooms along the D2 corridor

Time of dismissal from school: 7:00pm

Dress code: Full school uniform

Equipment: Stationery and planner, as required on a standard school day, packed lunch

Approximate cost: £16 each

**Trip 2: Up at The O2, Greenwich**

Up at The O2 is an experience students won't forget! Students will take part in an educational workshop focused on art or business, then will brave the climb up one of the most striking buildings in London's skyline. Please note, students attending this trip will be expected to climb the O2 - we do not recommend this activity for any students who suffer from a fear of heights or vertigo.

Students will travel to and from the O2 via the London Underground.

Time of arrival at school: 8.15am

Location: Various classrooms along the C2 corridor

Time of dismissal from school: 3:30pm

Dress code: Full PE kit

Equipment: Stationery and planner, as required on a standard school day, packed lunch

Approximate cost: £25 each

### Trip 3: Woburn Safari

Woburn Safari Park offers an escape to the wild plains, jungles and savannahs of Africa, without ever leaving the country. On this trip to the zoo, students will have a chance to explore the grounds of the zoo independently; take part in an outdoor learning experience and enjoy a guided tour (on their coach) of the safari section of the zoo.

Students will travel to and from Woburn Safari Park by coach.

Time of arrival at school: 8.15am

Meeting time and location: 8.25am in the Sports Hall

Time of dismissal from school: 4:30pm

Dress code: Full school uniform

Equipment: Sun cream, plenty to drink and a packed lunch

Approximate cost: £25 each
