Dear Parents/Guardians

Re: Welcome to Year 10

I would like to take the opportunity to welcome you and your child back into Ruislip High School and Year 10 after what I hope was a lovely summer. I know already that this is going to be an exciting year full of opportunities and I wanted to provide for you a place with key dates, expectations for the year and other important information.

Year 10 is a very important year in your child's education. As they enter Key Stage 4 and work towards their successful future, students will learn how to study for the coursework and examination elements of their subjects. I am pleased to share with you the link (click <a href="here">here</a>) to the Year 10 curriculum for the 2023/24 academic year which includes details of how students are assessed in each subject and how parents/guardians can support their child's learning outside of the classroom.

My expectations for the year group this year are unchanged: all students try their best, even when facing challenges; respect each other and all members of the school community; enjoy learning and taking on new opportunities beyond the classroom.

It is even more important this year that students keep the dialogue open with us if they feel under pressure as we want to support all our students on their journey to their first set of exams.

The Year 10 team will be working closely with students to ensure that they settle into a good routine again, especially regarding punctuality and homework and enjoy their time with us. I have sent a separate message regarding homework and the new set up for Study Club referrals, and I am grateful that parents/guardians are supportive if your child is referred to Study Club

To get the best out of every opportunity, students need to be here to take them. Attendance is very important to us at Ruislip High School. Of course, if a student is genuinely too ill to be in school, we want them to stay at home to rest and recover. However, it is important to recognise that we may not feel our best all of the time but students should strive to have the self-discipline and resilience to ensure that they are in school and learning. We expect students to have an attendance record of at least 95% across the year because every lesson missed is a GCSE lesson missed about a topic that could end up in their exam paper.

If, for any reason, your child is unable to attend school, we ask that you send a message on ClassCharts each day that they are absent so that we are able to authorise their absence. You will be contacted regularly by your child's form tutor to offer you support if their attendance falls.

At Ruislip High School we like to reward students who embody the school values. We run two reward trips every year which students are always keen to go on. The criteria for the trips are: minimum 95% attendance, fewer than five warnings, and no higher-level sanctions. It is a very selective trip but I know Year 10 will all do their best to be eligible for both reward trips.

It is vital that families and Ruislip High School work together in partnership: we are always happy to work with you for the best of the student. Form tutors or subject teachers are usually the first port of call if you have a question















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or a concern that you want to raise and I am also available to discuss any pastoral issues faced by your child.
