Dear Parents/Guardians,

Re: GCSE Results Day - Thursday 20th August 2026

I am sure you will share my congratulations to all students in Year 11 as the GCSE examination period is now over and the students can enjoy a well deserved break. The school is very proud of the hard work and dedication that the Year 11 students displayed this academic year and during the examination series.

Looking ahead, I wanted to share with you the plan for GCSE results day, which is taking place on Thursday 20th August. At Ruislip High School we pride ourselves on ensuring that all our students on results day receive the necessary support, advice and guidance they need as they navigate this important milestone.

The school will be open from 8.00am and students are invited to come into school with their parents/guardians to open their results with a member of staff. We will stagger the results collection throughout the early morning, to ensure that each student receives the support they need.

Results will be available for collection in school at the following times. Please arrive to school at the specified time to ensure the smooth running of the morning;

8.00am: students with surnames beginning - A, B or C
8.10am: students with surnames beginning - D, E or F
8.20am: students with surnames beginning - G, H or I
8.30am: students with surnames beginning - J, K or L
8.40am: students with surnames beginning - M, N or O
8.50am: students with surnames beginning - P, Q or R
9.00am: students with surnames beginning - S, T or U
9.10am: students with surnames beginning - V or W
9.20am: students with surnames beginning - X, Y or Z.

Students wishing to enrol at Ruislip High School Sixth Form must come into school to complete their enrolment during their appointment at results day, confirming which subjects they will study at Sixth Form. If you know your child wishes to enrol in our Sixth Form, but cannot be at school on 20th August, please contact Mr Sills, Head of Sixth Form, before the end of term via the school office to make alternative arrangements.

There will be a careers advisor in school during the morning of results day, who will be available to answer any questions about alternative post-16 options and applications to local colleges.

Any examination results that are not collected will be posted home in the afternoon. However, if you would like someone to collect the results envelope on a student's behalf then please provide the person collecting them with a signed letter from the student authorising the collection, plus photographic identification for the person collecting the results.

If you have any unwanted revision guides or school uniform items in good condition, we would be incredibly grateful if you could bring them with you on results day. On results day there will be donation points set up for the

FRIENDS of Ruislip High School, who will ensure these items are re-sold or recycled to support future students and the school community.

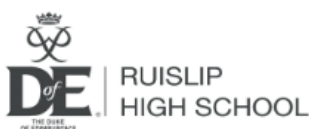
