**Re: Year 12 Theatre Trip to Six the Musical**

I am pleased to offer your child the opportunity to see the hit musical *Six* in London's West End on Thursday 18th June 2026.

The show is a modern retelling of the lives of the six wives of Henry VIII, presented in the form of a pop concert. It has won numerous awards, including the Tony Award for 'Best Original Score' and 'Best Costume Design', as well as winner of the Watson Stage Award for 'Best West End Show.'

The trip has been organised to provide an opportunity for our sixth formers to spend a summer evening in central London with their peers. There are also cross-curricular links with both the History, Music and Drama departments.

We will be departing from Ruislip High School at 16:30 for a 17:30 arrival at Charing Cross station. Students will then have two hours of free time to get some dinner and take in some local sights including Trafalgar Square and Leicester Square. Students will be unsupervised (but in groups of 3 or 4) during this free time, although staff will be contactable on the school mobile phone. The group will then meet staff back at the Vaudeville Theatre at 19:30 and take their seats for the show. We will return to Ruislip Gardens Station at approximately 22:30 where students will be dismissed to make their way home.

There are limited tickets available for this trip and places will be offered on a first come first served basis.

The total cost of the trip is £21, which can be paid via Parentpay by Friday 20th March. We have secured these discounted tickets (half the price of a standard ticket) as we are a school group. Parental permission can also be given on Parentpay, which accepts that the students will be unsupervised for two hours during their free time in London. Please ensure that your child has an Oyster or Zip card that is ready for a return journey to a Zone 1 station - the trip cost does not include tube travel.

I have no doubt that we will have an excellent evening.
