**Re: Year 13 Leavers Summer Party**

As Mr Sills mentioned in his [update](#) to you last week, unfortunately, not enough tickets were purchased for the Leavers' Ball and the event cannot go ahead as planned. We have since been working hard to organise an event which celebrates the hard work of this exceptional year group, and appropriately mark this significant milestone in their educational journey.

Therefore, I am delighted to invite all Year 13 to a Leavers' Party on Thursday 25th June at McGovern Park in Ruislip, the home of the London GAA. Please see the invite poster [here](#). The event will take place between 6pm-9pm in the Emerald Lounge. We anticipate a large number of teachers and support staff will be joining to celebrate with the students. This event is much more affordable, and better value than the Ball, at £20 per person which includes a full summer buffet. There will be music, awards, speeches, a photobooth and the dress code is 'dress to impress' (i.e. cocktail dress/summer suits).

The school will be refunding the difference in the cost of this event to parents/guardians who had purchased ball tickets and these students already have a party ticket. Tickets (£20 per person) are available to purchase on ParentPay and all students in Year 13 are invited. The deadline for payment is Friday 22nd May 2026.

In attending the Leavers Party, the school expects the highest standards of behaviour for all students. Students will not be able to purchase alcohol at the venue and they will also not be allowed to bring in any alcohol. Any student who arrives at the venue in an intoxicated state, or consumes alcohol during the evening will not be allowed entry and parents/guardians will be contacted to collect them. Additionally, if any student is found to have consumed drugs immediately prior to the Leavers Party, or attempts to do so during the evening, then parents/guardians will be contacted and the police will be called.

In order to ensure everyone understands the conditions by which students can purchase tickets for the Leavers Party, this form must be completed (please click [here](#)) by both the student and by a parent/guardian. Students who had previously purchased a Ball ticket do not need to resubmit this form. If the form is not completed, no ticket will be issued.
