Re: Year 13 “in person” Parents’ Evening - Thursday 9th March 2023

We would like to invite you to the **Year 13 “in person” Parents’ Evening on Thursday 9th March 2023**. This evening is an excellent opportunity to discuss your child’s progress in their A-Levels with their subject teachers ahead of the crucial final months leading up to their final A-Level and Level 3 BTEC examinations.

Appointments with each subject teacher should be booked using our online booking system that we used during the virtual parents’ evening period, but please note that all appointments will take place in person in school. The booking system - [linked here](#) - is now open, and appointment times will be made on a first-come, first-served basis. You will notice that, where a subject is taught by two teachers, some subjects will be offering a joint appointment with both subject teachers together, and some subjects will be offering two separate appointments - one with each teacher. Where the latter is the case, you are strongly advised to book appointments with both of the teachers for that subject.

There will also be appointments available to book with the careers adviser. These are listed as Head of Year appointments, but will be for appointments with the careers advisor.

By using the link below you will also be able to confirm your attendance at the evening. Please confirm your attendance and make your appointments by **Monday 27th February 2023 latest**, indicating whether or not you will be able to attend. Appointments will be held in school from **4:30pm to 7:00pm** (with the exception of Psychology and Economics appointments, which will begin from 4pm) and **students are expected to accompany their parent/guardian(s) to the evening**.
