**Re: Year 13 Post-18 Information Evening**

Each year, the vast majority of our Year 13 students apply to university. This year, over 90% of the year group have made applications through UCAS to a variety of higher education institutions throughout the UK. Some students have made applications overseas, and a small number are looking at apprenticeship and employment opportunities.

As part of our commitment to providing advice and guidance in navigating the next steps for our students, and to support you, their parents and guardians, we would like to invite you to a post-18 information evening at school. **This will take place at school on Monday 27th April, starting at 5pm.** We anticipate the event will finish by 6pm.

The aim of the evening is to give an overview of the next steps after the students finish their upcoming summer exams and how best to prepare for life beyond sixth form.

There will be a presentation from Mr Noble, Deputy Headteacher, myself as Head of Sixth Form, as well as the Schools and Colleges Liaison Officer from Royal Holloway, University of London. You, and your child, will receive vital information about:

- Preparing for the summer exam season
- What will happen on A Level/BTEC results day on Thursday 13th August
- Clearing, Confirmation and Decline my Offer
- Student Finance
- Applying for university accommodation
- Life at university

There will be an opportunity for questions after the presentation.
