- **The Big Goal:** Aim for an attendance rate **above 95%**. This doubles your child's chances of passing GCSE Maths and English.
- **Termly Updates:** You will receive an attendance summary at the end of each term so we can work together to support your child.
- **Appointments:** Please try to schedule appointments outside of school hours. Missing morning registration or Period 4 counts as an absence and drops their overall percentage.

Why Attendance Matters

Year 9 is an important year as students begin preparing for the choices and pathways that will shape their future. Because they are starting their official Citizenship GCSE course this year, excellent attendance is vital to ensure they don't miss key content. Regular attendance helps students stay on track, as even occasional days of absence add up over time and significantly impact their final outcomes.

This year, we are strengthening our partnership with families by introducing a more family-centred approach to attendance. At the end of each term, you will receive a summary of your child's attendance, along with guidance and support where needed to help maintain or improve it.

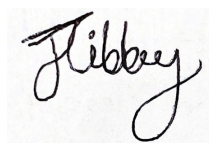
Ensuring your child attends school is a legal requirement, but our absolute priority is to support your family in overcoming any barriers to making that happen.
