GCSE Results Summer 2023

Ruislip High School is pleased to report some exceptional attainment by students in GCSE and other qualifications this summer. Overall, our pupils achieved 31% of grades at 9-7, 66% 9-5 and 83% 9-4 and we had some exceptional individual results:

- Nathan – Eight grade 9s; Mathematics, Combined Science, Spanish, Geography, History, English Language, Citizenship and a grade 7 in English Literature.
- Alexia - Eight grade 9s; Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Spanish, History, Drama, English Literature and a grade 8 in English Language.
- Matthew - Seven grade 9s; Computer Science, Combined Science, English Literature, Mathematics, Spanish, Citizenship and Grade 8s in Geography and English Language
- Benjamin - Seven grade 9s; English Language, Biology, Geography, History, Physics, Spanish Citizenship; Grade 8 in Computer Science, Mathematics and a grade 7 in Chemistry.

Gareth Davies, Headteacher of Ruislip High School said: *"I am delighted that our Year 11 students have not only achieved exceptional GCSE results but that the vast majority of students will be continuing their learning journey in Ruislip High School's sixth form. These results are clearly testament to the hardwork and dedicated students working in partnership with their families and the staff at the school."*

On Thursday 24th August 2023, Ruislip High School opened its doors to celebrate a successful set of GCSE results for our Year 11 students. After the success of our A Level and BTEC results last week, we were proud that our Year 11 cohort continued to exemplify our school's ethos of 'hard work equals success', with 31% of all grades awarded at 9-7, 66% at 9-5 and 83% at 9-4.
