Today, Ruislip High School celebrated the achievement of our outgoing Year 13 students on their A Level Results Day. As a school, we believe that hard work equals success and the A Level and BTEC results attained by our students exemplifies this, with 26% of all grades awarded to students being A*-A, and 76% of grades at A*-C. Our students' results will mean they will go on to a wide range of exciting destinations including studying at a range of prestigious universities and undertaking apprenticeships.

Beyond our university successes, we also have a number of students who have gained places on prestigious apprenticeships, including Parham and Alex, who are both beginning apprenticeships with leading accountancy firms KPMG and Orbis respectively, which will allow them to study towards a degree and qualify as accountants whilst working.

Ruislip High School is a school that is in and for the community, and one of our students who embodies this value is Adon, who joined us in Year 7. He is leaving Ruislip High School with A*A*A*A* grades in mathematics, philosophy, sociology and an extended project, and we are so proud of him. Thank you RHS for the last seven years!" Adon will go on to study philosophy and politics at University of Bristol.
